There are many ways to pray. Using words, being silent, drawing, singing or dancing.


What is the best way for you to pray?

Activity!

The picture on *sheet 2* is a *labyrinth*. It is a special, silent way of praying.

Colour in the labyrinth using crayons, coloured pencils etc. Use as many colours as possible; this will make it easier for your eyes to follow your "walking" finger. Choose a walking finger and breathe smoothly and then slowly move your finger along the pathway into the centre. At the centre hold your finger there and say thank you to God for something. Then slowly 'walk' your finger back to the entrance. You can also use this to say sorry to God.



Labyrinth

Colour in the labyrinth using crayons, coloured pencils etc.

Food Challenge

Coconut ice - can you get the colour right?

Ingredients:

200g Carnation condensed milk

225g sieved icing sugar

175g Desiccated coconut

A tiny drop of red food colouring

Method:

Step 1:

Mix together the condensed milk and icing sugar. Stir in the coconut and divide the mixture in half. Colour one half a pale pink.

Step 2:


Double line a small plastic box with cling film before placing the white mixture in the bottom, pressing it into a bar shape.

Step 3:

Form the pink mixture into a similar shape and press firmly together.

Step 4:

Chill in the fridge for 1-2 hours until firm then cut into squares.
